### **In Person**

- 3. Build deeper relationships with people through meeting them one on one (coffee, lunch, etc...). People are more likely to attend your life group or join your team after they get to know you and you know them.
- 4. During our Launch Sunday on January 24th take advantage of the opportunity to creatively promote your life group (ex: carry a prop, your curriculum, etc...) or team in the lobby before and after services.

### PRACTICAL TIPS FOR LIFE GROUPS

- 1. Meet in centralized locations (homes, coffee shops, workplace, online, etc...).
- 2. Encourage frequency for health (weekly meetings are best).
- 3. Facilitate discussion with group members resist the notion to just teach.
- 4. Encourage group members to read the Bible daily and not just at church or in life group.
- 5. Share ownership of the group by allowing members to help in different ways (bringing refreshments, planning outings, expressing care, etc...).
- 6. Share leadership by allowing your assistants and possibly group members opportunities to grow by allowing them to facilitate the lesson on occasion.
- 7. Attend events and services together and possibly sit together.
- 8. Grow through conflicts, (group life can have incredible highs and lows).
- 9. Facilitate care between group members by organizing meals for people who are going through transitions in life (such as funerals, births, etc...).
- 10. Encourage all group members to invite unsaved family and friends to the group.
- 11. Facilitate fun social gatherings for group members to bond with each other.
- 12. Follow one another on social media.
- 13. Be sure to make praying for one another an essential part of your group.

### WHAT LIFE GROUPS ARE

- They are biblical. As seen in the book of Acts, from the beginning of the church, Christians have gathered together around the biblical purposes to worship Christ.
- 2. *They are convenient*. A life group system supplies you with a venue in which it is easy to bring information with transformation.
- 3. They are effective at connecting people. Life groups are essential as the church grows because people still need personal connection and life groups are the best place for this to happen.
- 4. They are unlimited in reach. Wherever you have people you can have a life group.
- 5. They provide accountability. Each member has a support system.
- 6. They provide a safe environment. Members can explore their gifts and serving possibilities without feeling vulnerable or exposed.
- 7. They provide focus. If correctly directed, life group is a collection of people working on common goals not just one person teaching while others listen.

### **LIFE GROUP STRUCTURE**

Groups are broken down into Trimesters (3 seasons a year)

Winter Season: January - April

Summer Season: May - August

Fall Season: September - December

Groups are encouraged to meet weekly but some are bi-monthly.

### STRUCTURE

Here at KC we have 8 pillars of teams:

- 1. Administration (Front Desk, Facilities, Café, etc...)
- 2. Next Steps (Booth Connection, New Guest Connection, Discover Track, Baptism, etc...)
- 3. Experience (Parking Lot, Greeters, Ushers, Hospitality, Green Room, Security, etc...)
- 4. Creative (Instrumentalist, Vocalist, Production, Sound, Media, Lighting, dance, etc...)
- 5. Life Groups (Leaders, Assistants, Host, Coordinators, etc...)
- 6. Generations (Nursery, Pre-school, Elementary, Middle School, High School, Young Adults, Seniors, etc....)
- 7. Community (Food Distribution, Community Partnerships, Outreaches, Events, etc...)
- 8. Prayer (Early morning prayer, Prayer groups, etc...)

### HOW TO JOIN A TEAM

- Attend and complete Discover Track
- Inform a leader of a team that you would like to join and serve.
- Be faithful to carry out your responsibilities.

- 4. Able to submit under leadership (authority).
